Preventing Injuries During Flat Glass Handling—March 9th, 2011

The information provided in this "must see" webinar is taken from the US Occupational Health and Safety Administration (OSHA). These official accident investigations include the events surrounding seven fatal accidents and thirteen injuries which required hospitalization.

The webinar will review critical body locations which require protection and the primary fabrics available for cut protection. Evaluation methods to determine the level of cut protection offered by various fabrics will be reviewed.
